

## A03 | A Reference to Literature

Sketch an object from literature. Your object must come from your imagination from written or spoken word. After sketching your idea, draw that object in 2 dimensions in Rhino. On the two provided sheets of 1'x2'x3/4" plywood, you will produce two identical versions of your idea. One will be cut on our CNC router, the other will be printed on the plotter and transferred onto your material, then produced through the use of a band saw and sander. No finishing needed, edges should be sanded smooth, but can be sharp (no rounding on router or sand paper needed) No paint or finish, just raw plywood for crit. An "A" project will not be discernible which process was used to produce the project.
